
Since our program began in the fall of 1970, intercollegiate athletics has played




Joe Kleinschmit - Assistant Coach Men's Basketball




Eric Price #24 6'5" 180 So F Berkeley, CA


Zac Metzker #12 6' 2" 160 So G Lebanon, OR

Jim Dewey #40 6' 5" 230 Fr F Corvallis, OR



Dean Smith #44 6' 6" 220 Fr C Enumclaw, WA




K. C. Callero #14 5' 11" 160 Fr G Enumclaw, WA


Kevin Moreton #22 6' 2" 180 Fr G Burley, ID
