

BOARD OF EDUCATION ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

Academic Affairs and Workforce Development September, 2018

For accreditation purposes, and one way we track LBCC's mission fulfillment, we have 14 objectives, each with measureable metrics. Each objective is assigned to an Innovation Council. These councils (the Progression Council; the Workforce and Economic Vitality Council; the Values, Inclusion, and Cultural Engagement Council; and the Learning and Innovation Council) are tasked with the actual work of developing, implementing, and evaluating interventions designed to support each objective. We just wrapped up Year 2 and have set targets for Year 3. These objectives will last until our next Year 7 accreditation self-study and visit.

Below is a recap of how we did with 7 of those objectives this past year. We are still in the early stages on this work. I will share the additional 7 objectives in next month's board report.

Objective 1 - Programs respond to the needs of their external partners

A target percent of Career Technical Education (CTE) programs submitted advisory committee meeting minutes.

In order to be included, each program must submit minutes for at least two meetings per academic year as well as prove that its committee meets the institution's advisory committee standards.

- ♦ pass MTH 105 or 111 with a C or better within their first 30 attempted credits (given one academic year).
