What to expect in this class: synchronous and asynchronous instruction.

Attention: Your final grade will not be hurt if you can't attend a ZOOM session. All sessions will be recorded and available in MOODLE after each class.

*Some Zoom sessions are organized in 2 parts:

A. ZOOM (synchronous): Introduction of a new grammar piece + examples (40-50 min.).

B. On your own (asynchronous): Practice the new grammar pieces learned by completing activities from a Powerpoint previously posted in Moodle. These activities are considered homework and should be emailed to me the same day of the class before midnight.

Important

All the material (PowerPoints, extra practice, and other resources), and relevant class information besides MindTap; will be posted in Moodle. It is the student responsibility to check Moodle daily and do the work on time.

- ✓ Expand knowledge about Spanish speaking countries from different geographical regions.
- ✓ Better understand the relations between the United States and Latin America.

Pruebas parciales: There will be three (3) Chapter Exams (I call them "Pruebas") – See Calendar for details.

All the Pruebas will be assigned through my QUIA account. Each student will get a link in order to take each Prueba.

A practice test will be available in QUIA before each Prueba. Do not wait until the review day, or the last week to understand the grammar concepts, it will be too late! If you are having difficulty in the class, you are expected to seek help at the Tutoring Center, or with me during my office hours, as soon as possible. If you cannot take the Prueba on the day it is scheduled because of a <u>MAJOR</u> reason, notify me <u>IN ADVANCE</u>, so arrangements can be made to take it <u>within the following 2 days</u>. Otherwise, you will lose the points for the missed test.

Tareas (MindTap)

We learn a language through practice, and homework gives you precisely that. **Completing it on time is a key to your success**. 75% of the homework is assigned online through MindTap. The other 30% consists on exercises from the textbook, and some exercise packages that will be assigned by the instructor on the non-Zoom sessions.

MindTap grading policies: You get full **credit for homework turned on time. For every day the assignment is late after the assignment is due, 10% will be deducted from the assignment score**. You also have up to 3 attempts to submit (only the best attempt counts for calculating your grade). All MindTap homework is due at 11:59 pm of the due date.

Composiciones – (Assignment in Moodle)

You will write two (2) compositions of 200 words through Moodle. Each composition consist of a first draft (70%) and a correction (30%). I will then make written comments and mark errors (with the symbols indicated in the "Correction Code") on the first draft. You will then revise the composition and turn in the second version along with the first version for the final grade on the due date. **The second version will not be accepted without the first**. You must type and double space all second drafts. You must also highlight anything that is different from the first draft, and include a word count. Compositions that are not properly formatted or that do not fulfill the required page length will lose points.

You will receive a grade only after you turn in the corrections. If you turn in only a first draft, the maximum possible grade is 70%. Assigned dates for the compositions are in the calendar and should be turned in at the beginning of the class it is due.

Checklist for writing compositions:

- ✓ You are allowed to use your textbook, notes and dictionary (I recommend: https://www.wordreference.com).
- ✓ Use the vocabulary and grammar that we have learned in class (using grammar we have not learned will actually hurt your grade).
- ✓ Limit the number of words you have to look up to no more than 8 new words (underline them).
- ✓ Plan what you will write about and how to organize the information to avoid a random text.

- ✓ Do not write it in English first. If necessary, start with formulas you have learned in class.
- ✓ Keep in mind that you cannot write like you would in English. You need to learn how to walk before you can run. Keep it simple! Proof read!
- All work that you turn in for a grade must be your own original work. The use of computer- or internet-based translation programs, or a friend's help is not allowed. If I see evidence that a text was not entirely written by you, you will get a zero for the assignment. Re-occurrence may result in a failing grade for the class.

Conversaciones (2)

This is an individual assignment to demonstrate oral proficiency. Basically, you will have a conversation in Spanish based on a topic given in advance. In order to complete this assignment, each student will have to schedule 2 Zoom meetings (5 minutes long each) with the instructor. Please check pages 4 and 5 of this syllabus for specific dates and information
